Goals – Islamic Studies (2)

 - Rulings on salah (plus know all the adhkar in the prayers); including iqamah and adhan.
 - ☐ Stories of Prophet Ayyub, Yunus, Dawud
 - Seerah Madinah period
- ☐ Level 4 (Main book: 7):
 - ☐ Brief overview of taharah and salah and their rulings.
 - Basic figh types of rulings
 - Qadar: The story of Musa and Khidr
 - ☐ Belief in Allah and the truth of Islam
 - ☐ 'Alam al-Ghayb: The Hidden Realm
 - □ Adl and Fadl: Divine Justice and Grace
 - Seerah

Goals – Qur'an Memorization

- Goals for each level
 - Level 1: Depends on the kid's ability but try from al-Kauthar to an-Nas.
 - Level 2: Depends on the kid's ability but try from **at-Takathur to al-Mu'an**.
 - Level 3: Depends on the kid's ability but try from al-Qadr to an-Qariah.
 - Level 4: Depends on the kid's ability but try from **Ash-Shams to al-'Alaq**.

	Not to divert from mainstream positions.		
	Proper Islamic attire for both male and female teachers.		
	Maintain proper and kind mannerisms with the children.		
	Spend some time preparing for the lessons.		
	Need to communicate to the various WhatsApp group to keep parents/backup teachers up to		
	date.		
	Have good handle on tajweed (if teaching level 2 or above for the memorization class)		
Parents:			
	One parent/teacher meeting.		
	Spend 10-15 minutes at least every other day (ideally daily) with your kids to go over the homework		
	Make sure they are not falling behind.		
	Make sure the kids do not lose or throw away any handout.		
	Remind them to respect the rules of the school and the teachers.		
	Bring your own lunch.
