		Allah has made a promise to admit into Paradise anyone who is regular in performing their prayers at their fixed times.
		Salah will be a shining light on the Day of Judgement (yawm al-Qiyamah).

 - ☐ Hudhayfah said that whenever the Prophet (saws) happened to face any difficulty, he would at once turn to perform Salah.
- Missing the prayer:
 - Abdullah bin Amr (ra) said that the Prophet (saws) spoke about prayer one day saying: "If anyone keeps to it, it will be a shining light, evidence and salvation for him on the Day of Judgement. But if anyone does not keep to it, it will not be a shining light, not evidence, nor salvation. On the Day of Judgement, he will be associated with Qarun, Fir'awn, Haman and Ubayy bin Khalaf."
 - Qarun, Fir'awn, Haman and Ubayy bin Khalaf were enemies of Allah and enemies of His prophets, in the past.

We should take a break from playing or work and perform Salah on time. At home, if our family members are not praying, we should not take that as an example but perform Salah by ourselves. Rather, we should politely encourage our family members to perform Salah too. One of the greatest concerns our families will have on the Day of Judgement is whether they
