 □ Fajr 2 obligatory rak'ats
 □ Zuhr 4 obligatory rak'ats
 □ Asr 4 obligatory rak'ats
 □ Maghrib 3 obligatory rak'ats
 - ☐ Isha 4 obligatory rak'ats
- Sawm (fasting): Muslims should fast in the month of Ramadan

 Fasting means no eating/drinking from Fair until Maghrib
 - ☐ Fasting means no eating/drinking from Fajr until Maghrib
- Zakat (obligatory charity): Zakat is a small amount of money that a rich Muslim to poor people each year.
- ☐ Hajj: Muslims should go to Ka'bah and perform Hajj at least once in their life time if they can afford it.
