Islamic Studies – Week 2

- ❑ Hadith Jibreel:
 - ❑ Narrated by the great companion Umar bin al-Khattab
 - ❑ Angel Jibreel came in the form of a man to the Prophet Muhammad (صلى الله عليه وسلم).
 - ❑ Asked him four questions in order to teach the sahabah sitting around him about Iman and Islam.
 - ❑ Five pillars of Islam
 - ❑ Shahadah
 - ❑ Salah
 - ❑ Sawm
 - ❑ Zakat
 - ❑ Hajj
 - ❑ Belief in six pillars of Iman
 - ❑ Belief in Allah
 - ❑ Revealed Books
 - ❑ Angels
 - ❑ Messengers
 - ❑ Last Day (Day of qiyamah)
 - ❑ Destiny or fate (qadar)

Islamic Studies – Week 2

- ❑ Salah: Muslim must performed five daily prayers.
 - ❑ Fajr – 2 obligatory rak'ats
 - ❑ Zuhr – 4 obligatory rak'ats
 - ❑ Asr – 4 obligatory rak'ats
 - ❑ Maghrib – 3 obligatory rak'ats
 - ❑ Isha – 4 obligatory rak'ats

- ❑ Sawm (fasting): Muslims should fast in the month of Ramadan
 - ❑ Fasting means no eating/drinking from Fajr until Maghrib

- ❑ Zakat (obligatory charity): Zakat is a small amount of money that a rich Muslim to poor people each year.

- ❑ Hajj: Muslims should go to Ka'bah and perform Hajj at least once in their life time if they can afford it.
