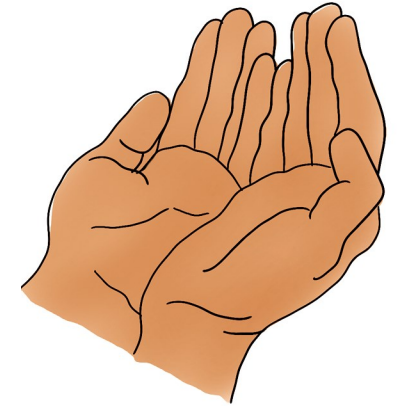




PROPHET ADAM (A.S)

'Our Lord! We have Wronged ourselves. If you forgive us not and bestow not upon us your mercy, we shall certainly be of the losers.'

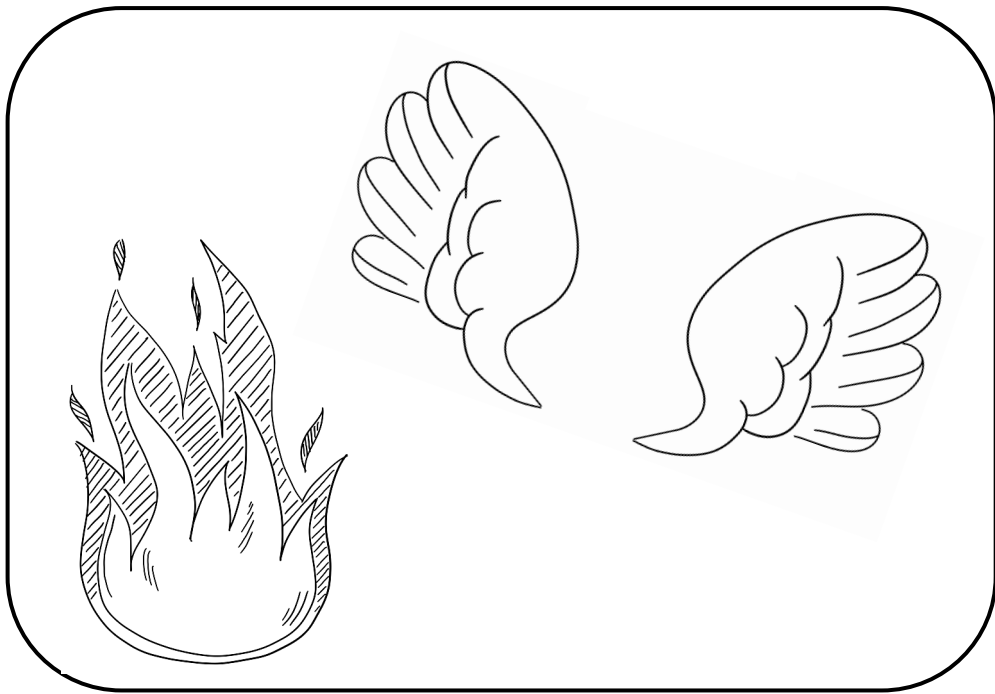
