## Islamic Studies – Week 8

- ❑ Why believe and care about the Day of Judgement?
  - ❑ We will see our good and bad deeds and Allah will decide where we will end up – Jannah or Jahanum.
  - ❑ We have prepare for the Day of Judgement and what Allah will ask us about.
    - ❑ The first thing we will be asked about on the Day of Judgement is about our five daily prayers.
    - ❑ If our prayers are good, then the chance are our rest of deeds will be good too.
  - ❑ What else will we be asked about:

عَنْ أَبِي بَرزَةَ الْأَسْلَمِيِّ رَضِيَ اللَّهُ عَنْهُ قَالَ: قَالَ رَسُولُ

اللَّهِ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ: «لَا تَزُولُ قَدَمَا عِنْدَ يَوْمِ الْقِيَامَةِ حَتَّى يُسْأَلَ عَنْ عُمُرِهِ فِيمَا أَفْتَاهُ، وَعَنْ عِلْمِهِ فِيمَ فَعَلَ، وَعَنْ مَالِهِ مِنْ أَيْنَ اكْتَسَبَهُ وَفِيمَ أَنْفَقَهُ، وَعَنْ جِسْمِهِ فِيمَ أَبْلَاهُ».

Abu Barzah al-Aslami (may Allah be pleased with him) reported that the Messenger of Allah (may Allah's peace and blessings be upon him) said:|"Man's feet will not move from their place on the Day of Judgment until he is asked about his life, in what he let it perish; about his knowledge, what he did with it; about his money, from where he earned it and on what he spent it on; and about his body, and how he wore it out."

## Islamic Studies – Week 8

- ❑ What do we learn from this hadith?
  - ❑ The hadith tells us we will be asked about several things:
    - ❑ How we spent our daily lives.
    - ❑ We should thus be careful how we go about our days.
    - ❑ We will be asked about what knowledge did we attain and what did we do with it. Did we make good use of it or used it to show off. Did we use it for good work or haram things.
      - ❑ The first type of knowledge we should attain is the knowledge related to Islam and then we should act on that knowledge.
      - ❑ If we learn how to pray, then we should also pray.
      - ❑ If we learn to not tell a lie, then we should be truthful.
      - ❑ If we learn to not backbite, then we should stay away from talking about others behind their backs, and so on and so forth.
  - ❑ We will be asked about how we got our wealth and how we spent it.
    - ❑ Did we get our wealth in a haram way or a halal way.
    - ❑ Did we spend our wealth in a haram way or a halal way.
    - ❑ Example, if a fraudster and defrauds people, is that a halal or haram way to earn money/wealth? It's of course a haram way.
    - ❑ If a person works as a mechanic and does an honest job but then sues the money to buy drugs, then earned the money in a halal way but spent it in a haram manner.

## Islamic Studies – Week 8

- ❑ Lastly, we will be asked about our bodies and what we did with our bodies.
  - ❑ Did we take care of it or did we feed it haram food or food we got from haram wealth?
  - ❑ Did we use our bodies to do good or use it for haram things. Example, did we use our hands to help our parents at home or did we use our hands to harm people.
  - ❑ Did we cover our bodies properly, for both men and women, or did we expose our bodies in a way Allah has not allowed us to do.
