Goals – Qur'an Memorization

- Goals for each level
 - Level 1: Depends on the kid's ability but try from al-Kauthar to an-Nas.
 - Level 2: Depends on the kid's ability but try from at-Takathur to al-Mu'an.
 - Level 3: Depends on the kid's ability but try from al-Qadr to al-'Alaq.
 - ☐ If your child is memorizing a surah outside the range listed above, then we will accommodate it.
